Question 8: In order to manage growth, it has been proposed that there be two Sunday services: 9-10 a.m. and 10:30-11:30 a.m., with Children's Religious Education Programming being held during the 10:30 a.m. service. Assuming both service programs are the same, which service would you be most likely to attend?

More than half of the respondents chose the current service time of 10:30 a.m. Comments reflect a wide variety of opinions from a preference for splitting services as opposed to a “costly expansion” to positive notes about the earlier morning opportunity. There are comments regarding this being an unsatisfactory direction, as well. All can be found in the second part of this report, as they were submitted.

This is the second question that was among the top two in terms of number of respondent comments. 27 utilized the opportunity to further discuss. It is of note that:

- All participants answered the question.
- 45 replied on the positive side of the scale (strongly agree/agree) while 5 replied on the negative side (disagree/strongly disagree).
- The range of comments points to a need to further educate members. What is the reason? How would it work? What is the cost? Although these pieces of information were shared in an open meeting and via video, it is an important this communication continue.
